Daily Ranch Camp Program

- 11:00 Camp opens with outdoor "guided" play. Boys and girls are closely observed for safety and positive social interactions. They are encouraged to run, climb trees, ride bikes, build their imaginary homes in the trees, and visit with the farm animals.
- 12:30 Lunch is served. It is a healthy balanced meal of various menus: either hotdogs, grilled cheese sandwiches, peanut butter and jelly, quesadillas, or chicken nuggets always served with veggies or fruit such as carrots and ranch, apples, oranges, grapes, watermelon; plus crackers or popcorn and a cookie for dessert.
- 1:00-2:00 Classes such as art, cooking, drama, farm animals, crafts.
- 2:00 Rest period during which the children watch part of a ranch animal movie each day and listen to a story being read. They may also read their own books at this time. Many of the younger children fall asleep.
- 2:45 Dress in swim and water clothes
- 3:00 Water activities such as splashing in our pool and/or water engineering (building dams and rivers in the play yard with the hose).
- 3:45 Dress to go home
- 4:00 Children who are leaving at 4:00 pm go home.

Day Care is available for an extra fee each day: 7:30-11:00am and 4:00-6:00 pm
